Paperwork needed for Notice of Marriage or Civil Partnership (Non Relevant National)

These are the documents we are permitted to accept to prove evidence of your name, date of birth, nationality, address and marital status.

If serving in USAF you will also need to bring your **military orders** showing that you are stationed at RAF Mildenhall or Lakenheath. If these have expired, you will need to show your **valid extension papers**. If you are living on base you will also need to produce your recall roster showing **your building and room number**. Proof of residence showing a box number **will not be accepted**. You must also produce your USAF ID card.

If you are subject to immigration control, please note that your waiting period may have to be **extended to 70 days**.

If you have difficulty producing any of these documents, please take advice from the office you will be attending for your notice of marriage.

If you are being married in the Church of England or the Church in Wales and you require the Registration Service to carry out the legal preliminaries, please contact us for further guidance.
